6. Responsible Pet Owner Guidelines

You are responsible for looking after your pet in line with the Animal Welfare Act 2006. Always get our permission before keeping a pet.

- Keep your pet under control at all times and ensure it is tethered in communal areas.
- Your pet must not cause a nuisance, odour nuisance, or disturbance to other people, including WPH staff and contractors.
- Ensure your pet does not access communal areas unless on a lead.
- Pick up your pets mess and dispose of it safely and responsibly.
- Do not allow your pet to damage any WPH property or garden. You will be charged for any damage your pet causes.
- If you go away on holiday or are away from home for a substantial period, make suitable arrangements for the care of your pet in your absence.
- Microchip dogs in accordance with government legislation (the number should be included on this form)
- Seek WPH permission to install a cat/dog flap or external pet housing.
- Do not breed or sell animals from your home.
- Do not keep a dog listed under the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991.
- Do not keep any livestock, illegal exotic, or wild animals in your home or garden.
- Ensure your animal is well cared for and not maltreated or neglected.
